A Bachelor's degree in Marine or Aquatic Biology, Environmental Studies, Environmental Toxicology or related field is required. Coursework and a strong background in chemistry are desirable. Previous experience in a laboratory setting and experience with Microsoft Word and Excel are preferred, but not required. On the job training will be provided; however, successful applicants are knowledgeable with regards to basic information regarding animal care and husbandry, water quality parameters and characteristics, and principles of aquatic research and laboratory testing. Key personal qualifications for this position include good interpersonal and communication skills, reliability, attention to detail, flexibility in schedule, the ability to follow written and verbal directions, and the ability to work both independently and within a team setting.
